A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY SIX THOUSAND SIXTY TWO DOLLARS (\$126,062.00)

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency provides Operation and Safety grants; and

WHEREAS, the funding is provided as a grant to the City of Johnstown Fire Department, as the applicant, and as a grant to update and replace self contained breathing apparatus; and

WHEREAS, the Assistance to Firefighters grant program will fund 90% (\$114,062.00) of the costs associated and the City of Johnstown will be obligated to a 10% (\$11,460.00) match; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown is desirous of entering into a contract agreement for the grant of Operations and Safety to replace aged and worn self contained breathing apparatus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign a grant agreement award number EMW-2015-FO-01931 for \$126,062.00 through the Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant program.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO SUBMIT THE NECESSARY PAPERWORK ON BEHALF OF GREENLAND CONSTRUCTION, INC. TO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN ORDER TO SUPPLY THE HIGHWAY RESTORATION AND MAINTENANCE BOND FOR THE ROXBURY SANITARY/STORM SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT PHASE 1 CONTRACT 2013-04.

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown is completing construction tasks involving sewer separation in the City in and around the Neighborhood known as Roxbury, and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown is completing construction projects on an area that is owned and the responsibility of the State of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, Greenland Construction, Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder for a project that will take place known as Contract 2013-04, and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation requires that a bid bond must be submitted to their offices confirming that the contractor is in possession of a highway restoration and maintenance bond, and

WHEREAS, Greenland Construction, Inc. has provided proof of a maintenance bond from The Hudson Insurance Group, and the Interim City Manager will provide proof of this documentation.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO EXTEND THE CURRENT AGREEMENT WITH URBAN DESIGN VENTURES FOR HUD CONSULTING FIRM FOR 45 DAYS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown's Department of Community and Economic Development receives an annual Entitlement Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under the Community Development Block Grant and the HOME Investment Partnership Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown hired Urban Design Venture as a consulting firm to assist in the CDBG and HOME plans and project activities on September 18, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the current Agreement expires on August 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown will request for approval to advertise a Request for Proposal during the City Council Meeting in September; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown is requesting a forty-five (45) day extension to the current Agreement between the City of Johnstown and Urban Design Ventures in order to continue consulting services for planning and project activities while seeking RPF's; and

WHEREAS, the extension would expire October 14, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council (hereafter the "Governing Body") of the Local Government Unit, directs and authorizes the Director of Community and Economic Development to extend the current HUD Consulting Agreement for forty-five (45) days.
