A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO TASK ORDER NO. 19 TO THE EADS GROUP, INC. FOR MODIFICATIONS TO THE SCHEDULE FOR RENDERING SERVICES FOR THE OLD CONEMAUGH SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Johnstown has entered into an agreement with the EADS Group, Inc. for professional services dated April 10, 2012; and

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Johnstown has entered into a Consent Order and Agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, and

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Johnstown desires to maintain compliance with Consent Order and Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Old Conemaugh Sewer Replacement Project, is a recommended capital improvement project for construction beginning in 2019; and

WHEREAS, it is the judgement of City Council that The EADS Group, Inc. be authorized to render engineering services for this project during the years 2016 – 2020.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZES THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO TASK ORDER NO. 19 TO THE EADS GROUP, INC. 

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO SEEK AND OBTAIN PROPOSALS FOR THE BORROWING OF GENERAL OBLIGATION NOTE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000 FOR PURPOSES OF DEMOLITION OF BLIGHTED PROPERTIES AND STRUCTURES.

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown ("Local Government Unit") has determined that there is a pressing need for the demolition of certain blighted properties within the City; and

WHEREAS, the current funding mechanisms available to the Local Government Unit are not a sufficient or expeditious means to meet the demolition needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit has determined that it is necessary, and in the in the interests of the City and its residents to pursue all possible options for resolving issues of blight via demolition, and

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit has determined that it is necessary to borrow for the purpose of demolishing blighted properties in a expeditious and effective fashion, by pursuing a loan for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit desires to explore any/all available options it may have to secure funds for purposes of expediting demolition of the City's blighted properties, and to examine any proposals for such funding;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council (hereafter the "Governing Body") of the Local Government Unit, directs and authorizes the Director of Finance City Manager, Finance Director, and/or his designee to seek proposals and/or written quotes for the borrowing of funds through a General Obligation Note not to exceed \$500,000.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A KEYSTONE COMMUNITIES FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT GRANT TO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$810,000.00

WHEREAS, the Department of Community and Economic Development for the City of Johnstown is desirous of obtaining funding to complete façade improvements in the Central Business District and Cambria City that are designed to stimulate private investment in properties, foster an attractive environment, and preserve the historical and architectural heritage of properties; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community and Economic Development for the City of Johnstown will assure the provision of the local share of project costs through requirement of a dollar for dollar owner match in specific project areas; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community and Economic Development for the City of Johnstown will reimburse the Commonwealth for the State's share of any expenditures found by PA DCED to be ineligible; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown will execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this resolution and furnish a copy of the Resolution to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager of the City of Johnstown is authorized to submit a Keystone Communities Façade Improvement Grant Application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$810,000.00.


