



**APPLICATIONS ARE NOW BEING ACCEPTED FOR THE POSITION OF
POLICE OFFICER WITH THE JOHNSTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Applications for Police Officer for the City of Johnstown may be obtained from the Police Department or by downloading them at cityofjohnstownpa.net. They can be picked up weekdays between 9 A.M. and 3 P.M. starting Monday, October 30th, 2017 until Tuesday, November 21st, 2017. Applicants must file completed, NOTARIZED applications with accompanying documentation, NO LATER THAN 12 NOON ON FRIDAY, DECEMBER 1st, 2017. Return in person or by mail to:

A \$30.00 non-refundable testing fee **MUST** be paid at the time the application is filed. Checks and money orders are to be made payable to the **City of Johnstown**. Individuals who took the Civil Service test previously are required to reapply and repeat the entire application process to be considered for employment. In Pennsylvania, applicants must have Act 120 and successfully completed the certification exam to be offered employment. Out-of-State applicants must be in compliance with POST, currently employed as a police officer and must successfully complete Pennsylvania's certification exam.

Applicants must pass a physical agility test prior to the written test. The agility test is scheduled for Saturday, December 16th, 2017 at 8 A.M. at the Greater Johnstown High School located at 222 Central Avenue. Applicants must then pass all four phases of the written Civil Service test to be administered after the physical agility test in the cafeteria at Greater Johnstown High School.
