RESOLUTION NO. 10108

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A GRANT APPLICATION FOR A PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (DCED) MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00, TO BE USED FOR URBAN CONNECTIVITY PROJECTS SUCH AS BIKEWAYS, ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, SIGNAGE, PLANTINGS AND LANDSCAPING AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ANY/ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE SAME.

WHEREAS, the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania makes available grants-in-aid for projects for Multimodal Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the planning activities of the City and such efforts as Vision 2025 seek to advance health, tourism and quality of life through outdoor recreation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnstown seeks to establish linkages to trails and bikeways to the Alleghenies, Laurel Highlands and beyond; and

WHEREAS, these connections further economic vitality by enhancing tourism; and

WHEREAS, the downtown urban connections comprise a vital link in accomplishing these goals; and

WHEREAS, this grant has no local match requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign all necessary documents associated with a grant application for a Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Multimodal Transportation Grant of \$500,000.00 and further authorizing the City Manager to take any/all actions necessary to effectuate same.
