



**APPLICATIONS ARE NOW BEING ACCEPTED FOR THE POSITION OF
POLICE OFFICER WITH THE JOHNSTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Applications for Police Officer for the City of Johnstown may be obtained from the Police Department weekdays between 9 A.M. and 3 P.M or by downloading them at cityofjohnstownpa.net. Testing will occur on January 26th, 2019. Applicants must file completed, NOTARIZED applications with accompanying documentation, NO LATER THAN 12 NOON ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 18th, 2019. A \$30.00 non-refundable testing fee must be paid at the time the application is filed. Checks and money orders are to be made payable to the **City of Johnstown**. Individuals who took the Civil Service test previously are required to reapply and repeat the entire application process to be considered for employment. In Pennsylvania, applicants must have Act 120 and successfully completed the certification exam to be offered employment. Out-of-State applicants must be in compliance with POST, currently employed as a police officer and must successfully complete Pennsylvania's certification exam.

Applicants must pass a physical agility test prior to the written test. The physical agility test is scheduled for 8am, Saturday, January 26th, 2019, at the Greater Johnstown High School Gymnasium located at 222 Central Ave. Applicants must then pass the written test with a score of at least 70% to be administered immediately after the physical test at the Greater Johnstown High School.

The residency requirement for the position of Police Officer has been eliminated.
