The Path of The Flood Trail connects to Downtown Johnstown, Cambria Iron Trail, Historic Incline Plane, Johnstown Flood Museum, AMTRAK and CamTRAN Stations, Mainline Canal Greenway, Jim Mayer Trail. The Path of The Flood Trail is also co-located with the Mainline Canal Greenway (Pittsburgh to Harrisburg) and the Pennsylvania leg of The September 11th National Memorial Trail (Flight 93 to Ground Zero, Manhattan and The Pentagon, Washington D.C.)
